



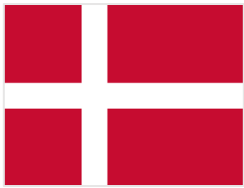
Austria

- One of the best seconds of the qualifications.
- Draw against France at home and loss against France away.
- Goalkeeper Manuela Zinsberger had 7 clean sheets in the qualifications. The most of all teams. In her 8 games, she conceded only 3 goals.



Belgium

- First in their group at the end of the qualifications.
- Loss against Switzerland away.
- Belgium's Tinne De Caigny is the top scorer of the qualifications with 12 goals.
- The player with the most assists during the qualifications is Belgian: Tessa Wullaert with 6 assists.



Denmark

- Ended first in their qualification group.
- Only one draw: against Italy at home.
- These women scored the most goals in the qualifications: 43.
- They had the most attempts: 265 and had the second most attempts on target: 118.
- Denmark's Nicoline Sørensen gave 6 assists. The biggest amount of all players during the qualifications.
- Denmark had both the first and the second place for the players with the most attempts on goal: Nadia Nadim with 25 attempts and Pernille Harder with 23.
- Sanne Troelsgaard committed 21 fouls. More than any other player during the qualifications.
- Denmark is the current vice-European champion.



England

- Host country
- Sarina Wiegman, who is now managing the Dutch team, will coach this team. She will start after she went to the Olympics with The Netherlands.



Finland

- They were first in their group.
- Finland only lost points against Portugal (draw).
- Linda Sällström scored the second most goals in qualification: 10.



France

- Ended on 1 in their group.
- Only lost 2 points against Austria away.
- This team scored combined the third most goals in qualifications: 42.
- *Les Bleues* had the second most attempts in qualifications: 258.



Germany

- Became first in its group without losing points.
- These women scored the second most goals in qualifications: 43.
- Germany had the third most attempts in qualifications: 111.
- Germany is the nation that was crowned European Champion women's Football the most: 8 times.



Iceland

- Iceland was one of the best seconds.
- Tied against Finland and lost against Sweden away.



Italy

- Second in their group: draw against Denmark away and loss against Denmark at home.
- Cristiana Girelli was with 9 goals the player with the third most goals during the qualifications.
- Laura Giuliani played 10 games and had 7 clean sheets. That's the biggest amount of the qualifications. She also conceded only 4 goals.



Netherlands

- The Netherlands are the reigning European Champions and the current World Cup runner-up.
- They ended first in their qualification group and won all their games.
- This team scored the most goals in the qualifications: 47.
- Sherida Spitse scored 10 goals. That's the second most goals in qualification scored by one player.



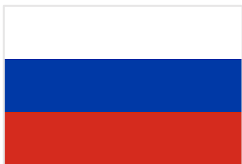
Northern Ireland

- Debutant.
- Ended second in their group: lost twice against Norway and tied 2 times against wales (0-0 and 2-2).
- Qualified for WEuro after they won their play-off games against Ukraine.



Norway

- Norway ended first in its group after winning all 6 games.
- One of its players scored the second most goals in qualification: Caroline Graham Hansen with 10 goals. With 6 assists, she also was the player that assisted to the most goals. And that's not all, she also was the player that had the most attempts: 21.
- Norway is the nation that lost the most finals. They lost 4 times.



Russia

- This country ended second in its group after The Netherlands and qualified through play-offs. Which they won against Portugal.
- Russia committed the most fouls in the qualification stage: 158.



Spain

- Spain ended first in its group after it only tied away against Poland
- This team noted the third most attempts in qualifications with an amount of 242 attempts. But they were the team that shot most on goal. 119 of their attempts were on goal.
- Spain's Jennifer Hermoso attempted the third most shots on goal: 21.



Sweden

- These women ended first in their group. They only tied against Iceland.
- Kosovare Asllani gave 6 assists. That's the biggest amount of the qualifications.



Switzerland

- Switzerland ended second in its group and won in the play-offs against the Czech Republic.
- This team only lost away games. Belgium and Croatia kept the points at home against this team.
